

START INTERACTING IN ISIZULU NOW

An introductory Course for Beginner Adults

Many of the interactions that we experience as we go through our day are predictable, repetitive and of a short duration. *Think about how you greet the same security guard every morning, or a colleague at work. Think about your interaction with the lady operating the teller at the supermarket, or the man filling up your car at the garage.* These encounters provide us with an opportunity to speak isiZulu in manageable doses on a regular basis, and provide an opportunity to cross cultural and social barriers in meaningful and practical ways. With that goal in mind, **ZuluMites** has selected 8 typical daily encounters and designed a course that equips the participants to engage with isiZulu speakers from the moment they leave the first session. This course is unlike any other on offer in the market, making foundational isiZulu accessible and possible for beginners to intermediate.

The 'Why' and 'Who' should do this course

This course has the potential to integrate companies in more practical ways, directly impact participants in their sphere of influence, and add value to any organisation's human capital. If you have ever berated yourself for not being able to speak isiZulu, feel disengaged from the people around you, attempted to learn isiZulu but got discouraged, or have never used what little Zulu you know for lack of confidence - then this course is for you! We run courses throughout the year, and are available to work onsite for a group of employees.

Lesson structure:

- Facilitator Dialogue/Roleplay
- Student Practice
- Short grammar explanation
- Opportunity to construct your own sentences with the grammar and vocabulary

The participants will walk out of each session equipped to engage with an isiZulu speaker in a specific situation and context. With repeated use, these set pieces will start to feel natural to the speaker and they will find new contexts to apply what they have learnt.

The course is given in eight **45 minute sessions**. The participants will receive a manual containing all the information provided during the session plus grammar explanations and exercises for home study. Two facilitators are dedicated to the course participants, and audio recordings of the role plays are also provided.
